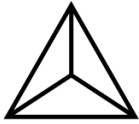

## MINUTES

### I. Call To Order

Chair Fletcher called the meeting to order at approximately 6:00 p.m.

### II. Approval of the Agenda and Meeting Minutes

It was **MOVED** by C/McGrain, **SUPPORTED** by C/Swope, to approve the agenda as printed. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

### III. Public Comment

Chair Fletcher invited the public to comment.

Mr. O. Norkin, Meridian Township Resident and area business owner thanked the Commission for inviting him, but stated that the money for the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala could have been spent more wisely on helping the community, and should be spent to better serving the purpose of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding allocated to the region. Further, he asked that the Commission postpone any decisions regarding transportation projects at this meeting.

Patty McPhee, Meridian Township resident spoke in support of Mr. Orkin's request that the Commission suspend or delay any business until January 2017. She expressed that she has recently learned of the Bus Rapid Transit project and feels that it would not be good for the community for reasons of cost and safety.

At the Commissioners request, Director Pigg described the extensive public notices, postings, and invitations that were issued to announce this regularly scheduled public business meeting of the Commission, which is followed by a celebration of the Commission's 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. The business meeting and the anniversary celebration are open and welcoming to the general public as well as TCRPC friends, clients, partners, and colleagues. Transportation project funds are not used to support the celebration event.

### VI. Committee Reports and Actions

#### A. Finance Committee

Financial Reports: Financial Statement for November, 2016 and Financial Audit of FY 2016.

C/McGrain reported that the Finance Committee did receive and review the November Finance Statement and recommends its approval by the Commission. In addition, the Finance Committee met with William Tucker IV from the CPA firm Gaffney & Abraham, PC. Mr. Tucker explained the audit process and reported its findings to the Committee. He attested to the Committee that TCRPC had a clean audit and there were no modifications or changes necessary. C/McGrain noted that

the Committee's questions regarding the 2016 Audit were considered and answered. As such, C/McGrain and the finance committee thanked the TCRPC staff for their work and recommend approvals.

**It was MOVED by C/Tennis, SUPPORTED by C/Lewis, to accept and place on file the November 2016 Financial Statement and the Financial Audit for FY 2016. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

## **B. Transportation Committee Reports**

### **1. FY 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) Amendments - Rural Task Force 6 (RTF 6)**

The Commissioners reviewed and discussed the list of RTF 6 projects proposed for amendment into the 17-20 TIP. C/Banas and staff planner Jim Snell discussed the changed budget amounts which were due to a number of small increases in various programs. C/Jones requested further information on some listed transit projects. Jim Snell, TCRPC Chief Transportation Planner, explained the ongoing special projects are minor and he clarified the scope of the projects.

**It was MOVED by C/Tennis, SUPPORTED by C/Lewis, to approve RTF 6's Requests for Amendment to the FY 2017 - 2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as presented. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

## **C. Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Project Amendment-Eaton County Road Commission**

C/Tennis stated that the Transportation Committees are working on ways to move CMAQ funded projects around in the schedule to accommodate changes to the BRT schedule as they clear federal funding steps. The Capital Area Regional Transportation Study (CARTS) Committee did provide an alternative plan, based on the information that they had before them. None of the proposed changes would go into effect until a more definitive change in the BRT schedule was established. The goal is to assure that the region access and use its full allocation of CMAQ funding for projects each year, even if BRT activities funded with CMAQ are rescheduled.

C/McGrain asked for clarification that the proposed CMAQ project changes were noticed publicly to allow for comment. Director Pigg confirmed that all notices were posted and sent per normal and the business meeting of the Commission, with this topic, was a public meeting. whether there had been a public notice and comment on this matter. It was confirmed by Susan Pigg that there had been.

C/Banas inquired about protecting CMAQ funds for the region and inquired about next steps in the BRT approval process. Director Pigg noted that the BRT was adopted into the region's transportation plans with public process and that federal funding allocations to that project for conducting required environmental review and design engineering are underway but only at 30% of the whole project. Going forward, explained Pigg, detailed changes to designs and costs may occur at the project development level and not appear before the Commission for decision making.

C/Banas questioned whether MDOT has reviewed the numbers. C/Jones advised that the procedure there is a comprehensive assessment review, along with comments from FTA, followed by a track of analysis and MDOT has reviewed what they have received.

C/Swope stated that the Commission doesn't have a regular meeting in January, 2017 and the February meeting falls after federal amendment deadlines. So, if the Motion is not adopted this evening then it could create a funding loss for the region. C/McGrain inquired about the federal approvals schedule and other amendments to the TIP. C/Lewis commended on the schedule of CMAQ funds. C/Draheim advised that it is best to protect the dollars and that it has already been agreed to by the Committee. C/Pohl advised that TRC had discussed whether to set priorities for other CMAQ projects if the BRT does not move forward in 2017.

**It was MOVED by C/Swope, SUPPORTED by C/Fletcher, to approve the proposed FY 2017-2020 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Alternate Project Listing as discussed. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

**VII. Public/Commissioner Comment**

None.

**VIII. Adjourn**

## EXECUTIVE/PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

### I. Call to Order and Agenda Approval

Chairman Fletcher called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m.

**It was MOVED by C/Watkins, SUPPORTED by Ch/Fletcher, to approve the agenda as printed. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

### II. Events

#### a. 60<sup>TH</sup> Anniversary Gala update – final plans

Executive Director Pigg advised that, as of this date, there are 60 RSVP's for the Gala. The reserve count is 100. A small men's choir will perform holiday music for \$250 with proceeds going to area Food Banks. Chairman Fletcher will offer welcoming remarks, and invite other leaders to comment or offer resolutions they have issued. There was discussion about this and other agenda items. It was further agreed that the Tri-County Commissioners from the three counties/city would make remarks. Director Pigg announced that HOM TV will have a draft video available this Thursday. The video will be about 4 minutes long and consist of interviews, pictures, and archival material. In addition to unveiling it at the event, it will be shared and available for more use in the future to describe the Commission and its purposes. The Commissioners' business meeting agenda and schedule was discussed. Finance Committee will meet with the Auditor at 5:30 pm. The Commission Business meeting will follow and be held at the same facility in a meeting room on the lower level. All appropriate notices and invitations will be issued. Notices and invitations will be widely posted and distributed. The Commission meetings and the event are open to the public and accessible to all.

#### Annual Dinner Venue – discussion

The Committee discussed the Annual Dinner Meeting venue is to be in Eaton County for 2017 and it was unanimously agreed upon that the venue be the Crowne Plaza. The Annual Dinner will take place on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday, January 25, 2017.

### III. December Commission Agenda

The Committee reviewed and discussed the draft agenda and agreed on the Committee Reports and actions.

**It was MOVED by C/Watson, SUPPORTED by Ch/Fletcher, to approve the December 15, 2016, TCRPC Full Commission Agenda as drafted. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

**IV. Executive Director's Report (attached)**

Executive Director Pigg gave a summary of her written report.

Director Pigg stated that she is developing a second Environmental Planner posting which will be distributed and posted in December with interviews planned for January.

S. Pigg explained that TCRPC was a founder of the Greater Lansing Area Clean Cities Coalition and currently houses GLACC in the offices. But, it has been a standalone organizations with non-profit status for many years now. The current contracted director Maggie Stritz-Calnin of Greater Lansing Area Clean Cities will not renew her contract to work for Clean Cities and the GLACC board members proposed that TCRPC take over the Clean Cities program. The position and program is currently funded by a Department of Energy grant as well as membership dues. The Grant could be transferred over to TCRPC and the responsibilities of administering the grant and the program would fall to the new TCRPC Environmental Protection planner with a memorandum of agreement between the GLACC and TCRPC for administration services. This would be similar to the current Stormwater Committee and Groundwater Management Board arrangements.

**It was MOVED by C/Watson, SUPPORTED by Ch/Fletcher, to approve the Executive Director's Report and to move forward with arrangements and negotiations regarding assumption of administering the GLACC. Final approval of any agreements would be placed before the Commission. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

**V. Other/adjourn**

**The staff and Commissioners noted that the Capital City Airport has hired a new Executive Director upon the retirement of Bob Selig. It was MOVED by C/Watkins, SUPPORTED by Ch/Fletcher, to invite the new Director of Capitol Region Airport to a future meeting of the Commission. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

**Seeing no further business before them, Ch/Fletcher adjourned the meeting at 9:55 am.**
